ASSISTANT CHOIR CONDUCTOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM 2025

A unique opportunity to join Parramatta's flagship symphonic choral organisation

Established in 2018, and led by its exceptional artistic director, Dr Sarah Penicka-Smith (AD), River City Voices (RCV) is gaining recognition for its multi-artform, inclusive, and unique collaborative choral programs. RCV's 2024 season included a sold-out performance of Mozart's Requiem with Western Sydney Philharmonic at St Patrick's Cathedral, Parramatta, a thoughtful, provocative and fun exploration of cancel culture with Macarthur Girls High, and our first ever originally scripted and staged Kids Proms - All Aboard with Beethoven - at PHIVE in Parramatta Square with Western Sydney Youth Orchestra.

An equally exciting and ambitious season of collaborative artistic programs and workshops is planned for 2025 with our cohort of 70 + committed and passionate western Sydney choristers.

The Role

First delivered in 2019/20, River City Voices is pleased to once again offer an aspirant choral conductor the chance to study and work alongside Dr Sarah Penicka-Smith.

Previous conductors in this Development Program have included: Alex Siegers, Dr Philip Eames, Joanna Brooke and Oliver John Cameron.

The program is tailored to your needs through discussion with the AD, and a schedule created comprising rehearsal dates during each block during which the ACC will observe (minimum 50% of all calls whether observing and/or conducting), conduct selected items, and ultimately lead choir rehearsals with potential to participate in performances. There will also be opportunities for individual mentorship. Nb: The amount of podium time is dependent on the number of rehearsals attended.

The choir rehearses every Thursday evening in Parramatta (6.30-9.30pm), generally in 10–11-week blocks culminating in a performance.

Remuneration

This is not a salaried position, however a scholarship amount of \$4,400 will be made available in addition to payment for each rehearsal that the Assistant leads in the absence of the AD.
